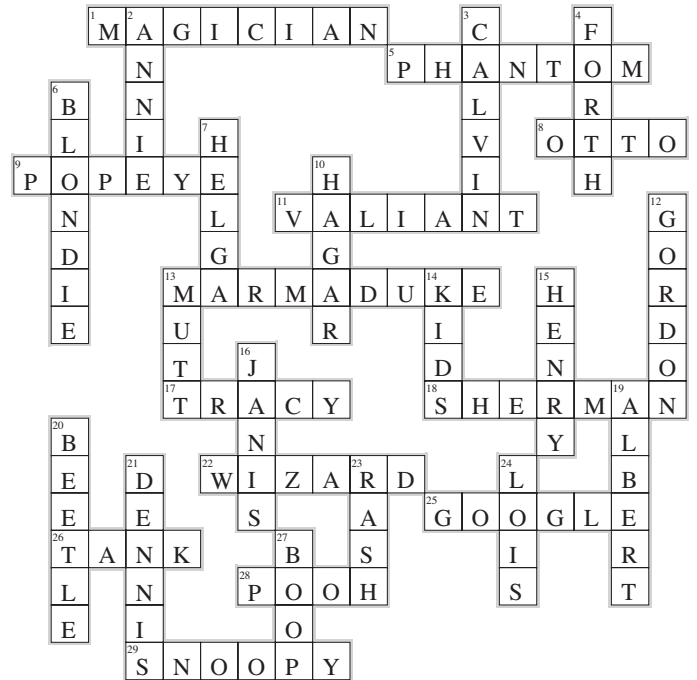

11. Generally Speaking:
